



School Refund Policy

If Park Shore opens and then has to close due to New York State or the Office of Family and Children's Services (our licensing agent) restrictions, all prorated refunds/credits will be paid by September 30, 2021.

If Park Shore has to close due to New York State or the Office of Family and Children's Services (our licensing agent) restrictions, Park Shore's virtual program will begin 5 days after closing. There will be no charge for the first 4 consecutive weeks of virtual learning as long as there is no tuition balance owed. The regular monthly tuition will be used for this four week virtual program.

If Park Shore has to remain closed and parents want to continue the 5 day virtual program after the first 4 weeks of being closed the monthly virtual tuition for this program will be as follows;

Preschool: \$395

Pre-K: \$495

Kindergarten: \$595

For those parents who do not want to continue the virtual program, refunds/credits (if any) will be calculated after the first four consecutive weeks that Park Shore was closed due to New York State or the Office of Family and Children's Services restrictions.

Should school days be missed due to closure, Park Shore has the right to open for vacation weeks (December, February, March/April and June extended school). These days will be counted as school days for all families regardless of attendance.

The total number of weeks/days closed (used for calculating any applicable refunds/credits) will be reduced if Park Shore opens during a school vacation.
