

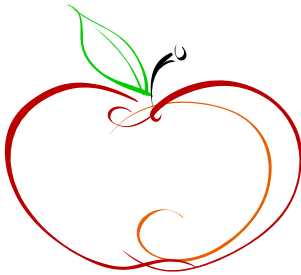

Special Happenings

**Apple tasting and
graphing**

Read Aloud: When Autumn Comes, Apples, poems, Pick a circle gather squares, The Leaves on a tree, weekly reader, Flannel Board stories, Apple Orchard Riddle
(these are just a few books we are reading)

Vocabulary/Sight Words: colors, shapes, apples, names, big, biggest, largest, sorting

Class Discussions: reviewing classroom rules, differences between Summer and Autumn, Johnny Apple Seed

Math: Introduce numbers, matching apple numbers, calendar, sequencing, graphing, math concept words, object shape match, graphing

Science: Fall/Autumn, apple life cycle, seasonal changes of an apple tree, apple seed planting. (what will happen?), parts of an apple, apple tasting

Fine Motor: practice scissor usage and following the lines when cutting, learn how to use a glue bottle (just a dot not a lot), Writing from left to right

Gross Motor: Stamp feet to pretend to mash apples game

Dramatic Play – We will pretend to work at an Orchard Stand and sell green, yellow, red apples.

Author of the Month: Anne Rockwell continues

Song of the Week: Jack and Jill

Letter of the week: introduce the letters of the alphabet. Discuss how each letter has its own sounds (phonetic value of letter)
