We will be reviewing the letters, sounds and formations this week. We hope that next week we will start the sight words. A letter about that will go home next week.

We will talk about election day and what it means. We will be voting on Monday for our snack. The children will be going in the class voting booth and filling out their own ballot which we will count together

This week we will be working on...

Reading/Writing: We will continue to work on beginning sounds and trying to spell words by stretching out the word. We will continue to work on using our spaces. Spaghetti Spaces for letters in words and Meatball Spaces between words in a sentence. We will also work on punctuation.

Math: We are starting topic 3 this week.

HWT: We will start working on this workbook this week. The workbook does not do the letters in alphabetical order they work on capitals and then lowercase letters. They also work on letters that have the same movements. We start with jump up letters.

SS/Science: We will continue to discuss our families. We are practicing our last names as well. We will also start our first big unit - The Rainforest. This week we will talk about the layers in the rainforest and we will start our information book.
