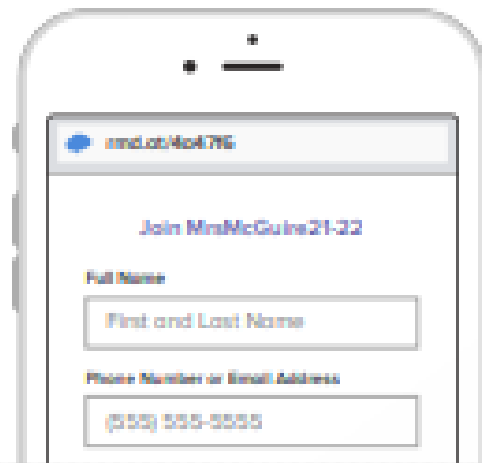
Pick a way to receive messages for **MrsMcGuire21-22**:
