We are working on our sight words in class. The students seem to be enjoying the new routine of sight word work in the morning. Please keep the books they are creating in a zip loc bag at home that they can revisit from time to time to read and practice their words.

We will start decorating the classroom for Thanksgiving and Hannukah as this starts the Monday after Thanksgiving.

We continue to work on our beginning sounds and will eventually move to ending sounds. Please practice this at home. It is something as simple as when you are eating dinner ask what items on the table start with, when you are hanging out ask them to find something that starts with a certain letter and of course continue to use the packet that was sent home a few weeks ago.

This week we will be working on...

Reading/Phonics: We will continue to work on beginning sounds, rhyming and syllables.

Math: We will continue Unit 3 and finish up with an assessment. We will then start Topic 4.

Writing: We will be writing about what we are thankful for. We will be adding thankful notes to our turkey mural. We are also still working on drawing and adding details which will carry us into labeling our own pictures.

HWT: We were supposed to start our HWT workbook last week but did not get to it. We will do this this week.

SS/Science: We will also be talking about Thanksgiving and what it means to be thankful. We will be talking about the Native Americans and the Pilgrims and will finish up this unit with our very own feast (aka party)-Next Week.

Sight Words: Last week the students got their first list (orange). We will be going over a word a day and reviewing all words daily. Each day we will do a rainbow activity- This activity has them spelling the word and saying the word at least 12 times as they write it in the colors of the rainbow. We then do a book for each word that has then writing it and reading it and even reading a sentence with it in it. Once we have a few words under our belt we will play games with them and have center activities with them.

Continued practice at home with be so helpful to your student and aide in their success.
