AT HOME LEARNING TIPS

PLEASE HAVE YOUR CHILDREN USE A PENCIL TO COMPLETE THEIR
HOMEWORK! COLORING THE PICTURES IS FINE BUT PLEASE TRY YOUR BEST
TO REFRAIN FROM USING MARKERS TO WRITE LETTERS, NUMBERS ETC.

IF YOUR CHILD IS HAVING TROUBLE "PINCHING"THE PENCIL, YOU CAN HAVE THEM HOLD A SMALL ITEM DOWN WITH THE THREE FINGERS USED TO SUPPORT THE PENCIL. THIS WILL FORCE/REMIND THEM TO USE THE REMAINING TWO FINGERS TO PINCH THE PENCIL!

MATH, SCIENCE, SOCIAL STUDIES

STUDENTS WILL EXPLORE WHY LEAVES CHANGE COLOR, WHAT HAPPENS DURING THIS SEASON, AND HOW ANIMALS ADAPT IN THE FALL. THEY WILL ENGAGE IN LEAF OBSERVATIONS AND SORT LEAVES BY SIZE, COLOR, AND SHAPE. ADDITIONALLY, WE WILL USE OUR FIVE SENSES TO INVESTIGATE LEAVES. STUDENTS WILL BE INVITED TO MAKE A "LEAF CREATURE" WITH LEAVES WE COLLECT FROM OUR SCHOOL YARD

WE HAVE BEEN WORKING ON NUMBER RECOGNITION AND NUMBER SENSE EVERY DAY. DURING CIRCLE TIME, STUDENTS ARE INVITED TO COUNT THE DAYS WE HAVE BEEN IN SCHOOL, WHAT TWO NUMBERS MAKE UP A TWO-DIGIT NUMBER, AND THE NUMBER OF MONTHS IN A YEAR. SMALL GROUP ACTIVITIES HAVE BEEN CENTERED ON HELPING STUDENTS RECOGNIZE NUMBERS AND SELECT CORRESPONDING ITEMS THAT MATCH THOSE NUMBERS. THESE NEXT TWO WEEKS WE WILL BE FOCUSING ON THE NUMBERS 2 AND 3.

THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE WILL BE INTRODUCED DURING THESE NEXT TWO WEEKS. WE WILL READ A BOOK ABOUT OUR PLEDGE AND OUR FLAG. WE HAVE A CLASS MICROPHONE THAT EACH STUDENT WILL GET A CHANCE TO USE TO RECITE THE PLEDGE AS WE BEGIN TO LEARN IT! WE WILL ALSO TALK ABOUT TRANSPORTATION AND SORTING BETWEEN LAND, SEA, AND AIR.
