- **ART:** Valentine's Day and Dental Health related crafts SPANISH: Introduction to "Febrero" (February), "amor" (love), "corazón" (heart), "abrazo" (hug), "amigos/as" (friends), "amor" (love), "dulce" (candy) and "flores" (flowers). Reviewing "Invierno" (Winter), "frio" (cold), "hielo" (ice) and "nieve" (snow). Days of the week and colors. Parts of the body "cabeza" (head), "pelo" or "cabello" (hair), "cara" (face), "ojos" (eyes), "nariz" (nose), "oidos" (ears), "boca" (mouth), "dientes" (teeth), "manos" (hands), "dedos" (fingers), "estómago" (stomach), "piernas" (legs), "pies" (feet). Greetings "hola" (hi), "adios" (bye), "¿Cómo estás?" (How are you?), "muy bien" (very well), "gracias" (thank you)
- VOCABULARY WORDS: Winter, February, roses, chocolate, candy, poem, hug, love, Cupid, heart, arrow, cookie, friends, flowers, card, and teddy bear
- WRITING: Students' name recognition, spelling, and tracing. In class worksheets on various topics in unit.



## **UNITS OF STUDY**

- CIRCLE TIME: "Hello" and "Days of the Week" songs in English and Spanish. Daily talk about our feelings. Weather discussion throughout the week. Continuation of the seasons and months of the year.
- **LETTER OF THE WEEK:** Review of the alphabet with a focus on the letters Oo and Pp, their sounds, and words that start with each letter. Difference between uppercase and lowercase letters.
- **COLOR:** Review all colors (in English and Spanish) with a focus on Valentine colors.
- SHAPE: Review all shapes.
- **READ ALOUD:** Stories related to Valentine's Day, Dental Health and books handpicked by students. Review of the basic parts of a book (front cover, back cover, spine, pages, book title, author, and illustrator).
- MATH: Number Recognition. Counting from 1-20. Daily Calendar: counting the days of the week and each number of the day. Review and practice of sequencing, patterns, and graphing on unit theme.
- **SCIENCE IN CLASS:** Winter themed STEAM experiment "Exploding Snowman." For this fun experiment, we will use a bag, baking soda, vinegar, paper towel, and food coloring. We will observe the chemical reaction as the bag starts to fill with carbon dioxide (and that's why you see the bag start to swell up) until the pressure is too much and ... BOOM! We will also make our own Valentine's Day science experiment: Dancing Hearts! For this experiment we will be using baking soda, vinegar, water, and candy hearts. The baking soda and vinegar react to form carbon dioxide, water, and a salt. Carbon dioxide gas is the bubbles you see during the reaction. The bubbles rise to the top, lifting the candy hearts up. Bubbles leave the bottom of the candy heart, and the heart falls back down. The bubbles are essentially pushing the candy around making them seem to dance.
- **CENTERS:** Various activities that promote the use of fine and gross motor skills. Activities that also help develop sensory, cognitive, and social skills (ex.: building, puzzles, movement, dramatic play, problem solving)
- FINE MOTOR SKILLS: Continuation of proper pencil grip, tracing, use of glue sticks, and use of scissors.
