Learning Focus

We will continue to stress the importance of playing nicely together, respecting one another, sharing, and personal space. Fine motor skills development continues, reading, writing and spelling our names, practice last name spelling, writing and recognition, phone number and address practice as well as shape and number review. Unit themes include seasonal study: Winter; Rhyming; Opposites A B B B patterns; Months of the year; Leap year; March and **author study Dr Seuss.**

- **Letter of the week:** "Rr" and "Ss" / phonemic word list, letter drawings and smart board use: Numbers "16 & 17"
- **Read Alouds:** Stories related to Unit themes and Rhyming
- **Author Study: Dr Seuss**
- **Math:** Daily Calendar and weather, counting days of the week, months of the year, sunny, cloudy and rainy days and intro to graphing and pattern, counting to 100
- **Vocabulary/Sight Words:** Leap year, March, Lion, Lamb, spring, wind, weather and Dr Seuss
- **Science:** fly a kite, blow bubbles and cloud watching
- **Art:** March lion and lamb craft
- **Music & Movement:** Percussion instruments
