MATH, SCIENCE, SOCIAL STUDIES

THIS SPRING, WE WILL BE EXPLORING THE FASCINATING WATER CYCLE AS PART OF OUR SCIENCE LESSONS. BY LEARNING ABOUT HOW WATER MOVES THROUGH THE ENVIRONMENT (EVAPORATING, FORMING CLOUDS, AND FALLING AS RAIN). WE WILL BE LAYING THE FOUNDATION FOR UNDERSTANDING LARGER CONCEPTS, LIKE THE PLANT CYCLE.

THIS MONTH, WE ARE DIVING INTO THE CONCEPT OF SUBTRACTION! WE WILL BE TEACHING THE CHILDREN THAT SUBTRACTION IS A WAY OF TAKING AWAY FROM A GROUP. WHEN WE ADD, WE START WITH TWO GROUPS AND BRING THEM TOGETHER TO MAKE A BIGGER GROUP. HOWEVER, WHEN WE SUBTRACT, WE ONLY HAVE ONE GROUP, AND WE ARE TAKING AWAY FROM THAT GROUP. WE'LL BE USING FUN, HANDS-ON ACTIVITIES TO HELP THE CHILDREN UNDERSTAND THIS IDEA, LIKE USING TOYS OR COUNTING OBJECTS TO SHOW HOW SUBTRACTION WORKS.

WE WILL BE EXPLORING THE TOPIC OF FAMILY TRADITIONS IN OUR CLASSROOM! WE WILL BE DISCUSSING HOW DIFFERENT FAMILIES CELEBRATE VARIOUS HOLIDAYS AND TRADITIONS, AND HOW THESE CELEBRATIONS CAN LOOK DIFFERENT DEPENDING ON WHERE WE LIVE OR WHAT OUR FAMILY VALUES. WE WILL ALSO TALK ABOUT SPECIAL SPRING TRADITIONS LIKE SPRING CLEANING, ENJOYING MORE OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES, AND CELEBRATING THE ARRIVAL OF WARMER WEATHER.
