ADDITIONALLY, WE'LL HAVE OUR LETTER OF THE WEEK SHOW AND TELL, WHERE STUDENTS CAN PRACTICE PUBLIC SPEAKING IN AN ENGAGING AND ENJOYABLE WAY!

MATH, SCIENCE, SOCIAL STUDIES

IN THE COMING WEEKS, WE WILL DIVE INTO THE PLANT CYCLE! OUR HANDS-ON LEARNING EXPERIENCE WILL INVOLVE PLANTING GRASS SEEDS IN CLEAR CUPS WITH SOIL, GIVING US A VIEW OF THE GROWING PROCESS. AS THE SEEDS SPROUT, WE'LL BE ABLE TO OBSERVE THE ROOTS DEVELOPING AND TRACK THEIR GROWTH OVER TIME. THROUGHOUT THIS PROJECT, WE'LL BE MAKING PREDICTIONS ABOUT WHAT WILL HAPPEN DURING THE PROCESS, ESTIMATING HOW LONG IT WILL TAKE, AND DISCUSSING THE ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS PLANTS NEED TO GROW.

FOR THE REST OF THE MONTH, WE WILL CONTINUE REVIEWING SUBTRACTION
WHILE HELPING STUDENTS UNDERSTAND THAT A PLUS SIGN MEANS ADDITION
AND A MINUS SIGN MEANS SUBTRACTION OR TAKING AWAY. WE WILL ALSO
REVISIT NUMBER SEQUENCES AND PRACTICE COUNTING ON FROM A GIVEN
NUMBER. NOW THAT STUDENTS HAVE LEARNED BOTH SKILLS, WE WILL FOCUS ON
RECOGNITION AND HELP THEM DISTINGUISH WHICH MATH SKILL TO USE IN
DIFFERENT SITUATIONS. WE WILL ALSO CONTINUE OUR UNIT ON TEEN NUMBERS,
FOCUSING ON 17 AND 18.
